WHY ISN'T THE LENTEN SEASON the same time each year? Easter, the conclusion of the Lenten Season, is observed and celebrated on the first Sunday following the full moon that occurs on or after March 21st, or one week later if the full moon falls on a Sunday. In other words, Easter is between March 22nd and April 25th. Why such a strange way of determining the date? This was originally a time of a pagan holiday (Eostre) honoring a goddess of light and spring (Teutonic). Early Christians redeemed this pagan holiday and honored the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

SPECIAL DEACON FUND OFFERINGS are received each Sunday we share in our Lord's Supper. Funds received are used to assist members of our Village Church family and others in times of serious need--such as medical emergencies, clothing and utility bills.
