Although the mid-February holiday celebrating love and lovers remains wildly popular, the confusion over its origins led the Catholic Church, in 1969, to drop St. Valentine's Day from the Roman calendar of official, worldwide Catholic feasts. Some Catholic parishes, however, observe the feast of St. Valentine.

The roots of St. Valentine's Day lie in the ancient Roman festival of *Lupercalia*, which was celebrated on Feb. 15. For 800 years the Romans had dedicated this day to the false god Lupercus. On *Lupercalia*, a young man would draw the name of a young woman in a lottery and would then keep the woman as a companion for the year.

Pope Gelasius I was, understandably, less than thrilled with this custom. So he changed the lottery to have both young men and women draw the names of saints whom they would then emulate for the year. Instead of Lupercus, the patron of the feast became Valentine. For Roman men, the day continued to be an occasion to seek the affections of women, and it became a tradition to give out handwritten messages of admiration that included Valentine's name.

THE LENTEN SEASON begins with Ash Wednesday on February 17, 2010. Lent is the forty day period between Ash Wednesday and Easter, not including Sundays, of penitence and preparation for Christ's death and resurrection. Some traditions have fasting, others particular studies. We are encouraging you to utilize a daily Lenten devotional. A number of different devotionals are available on the counter in our Lobby. We encourage you to pick up one of these devotionals and use it each day during Lent.

WHY ISN'T THE LENTEN SEASON the same time each year? Easter, the conclusion of the Lenten Season, is observed and celebrated on the first Sunday following the full moon that occurs on or after March 21st, or one week later if the full moon falls on a Sunday. In other words, Easter is between March 22nd and April 25th. Why such a strange way of determining the date? This was originally a time of a pagan holiday (Eostre) honoring a goddess of light and spring (Teutonic). Early Christians redeemed this pagan holiday and honored the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
