As examples, two people are involved in the counting and depositing of each Sunday's offering; two different people review and sign each church check; all bank statements are reviewed by the pastor and then reconciled by our Treasurer; our Session receives and reviews financial statements each month; and our financial records are reviewed annually by an outside accounting firm or individual not involved in the finances of our church. Each year we make available an annual report of our various activities, including financial information for the previous year and our Session approved budget for the current year. Also, our financial records are available for review by our members of our congregation upon request. It is our desire to be the best possible stewards of the funds received in order to further our Lord's ministry through this church.
